Dear Parents and prospective Grade 2's

Welcome to Grade 2. We hope that the year ahead will be a happy and successful one. In order to start the year on an organized note, we request that you provide the following items for your child. We are sending the list now so that some of these items can be included in your child's Christmas presents. Please bear in mind that many of the items below need replacing during the year.

1. 10 HB pencils – black and red – no erasers on end, please
2. 1 large pritt per term (no liquid glue or small pritts please)
3. 1 box of pritt / colleen pencil crayons (12 colours – must be replaced when finished or broken)
4. 1 packet Steadtler 14's retractable wax crayons (contains gold and silver available at Checkers)(must be replaced when finished or broken)
5. 1 metal sharpener (The plastic ones do not sharpen properly)
6. 1 good quality firm ruler (30 cm)
7. 1 soft rubber
8. 1 pair of sharp nosed scissors
9. 1 art apron or Dad's old shirt
10. 1 30 cm by 30 cm material bag for homework (seal with studs or velcro)
11. 1 material chair bag (width 43 cm) - royal blue
12. 3 Flip file (thirty pages)
13. 1 2 λ ice-cream container (No space cases!)
14. 1 thick wax crayons
15. 1 box pastels (± 16 colours)
16. 1 box of tissues (200)
17. 1 large material pencil case



ALL THESE MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME. All crayons and pencils must be INDIVIDUALLY marked. No time can be spent looking for items which are not clearly marked.

Grade 2's are not required to change clothing for Physical Education but they do need a blue school costume and swimming cap for water activities. Pupils who take part in sport are required to wear a blue Lorraine golf shirt and a pair of white shorts. The golf shirt will be available at the office.

We still plan to raise funds for our Foundation Phase Department by selling cup cakes every Friday. In order to save valuable time we request that you send R30,00 to pay for your child's cake in advance. Each mother will be requested to bake cakes twice during the year.

Reading books are no longer supplied freely by the Department of Education. As we have a new reading series, please note that if a book is lost or damaged, the whole set will have to be replaced. You will have to pay R258 for a lost book. The writing books and plastic covers will only be issued once they have been paid for. Please send this money to school on the FIRST day so we can start working immediately.

Please send the following amounts in cash in an envelope on the first day. Our office cannot cash cheques and we need to allocate each amount to different sections.

- R170 - R120 (writing books and plastic covers)  
R30 (cookie money)  
R20 (project money)
