STATIONERY LIST 2026 - Grade 3 Requirements:

- 1 x 50-page Flip File
- 1 x Homework Bag / Zip Bag
- 1 x Pencil Bag (NO Space Cases)
- 20 - HB Pencils (5 per term, black and red – no rubber at the back)
- 4 x Pencil Crayons of a good quality (12 pack – 1 per term)
- 2 x Retractable crayons (12 pack)
- 4 x Large Pritt Glue Sticks – 22g (1 per term)
- 1 x Metal Sharpeners (No plastic sharpeners)
- 4 x Erasers (1 per term)
- 1 x Pair of good quality scissors (Please confirm left or right-handed)
- 1 x Large box oil pastels (24 colours)
- 1 x 30 cm ruler with clear cm markings – see Point 2 below
- 8 x Whiteboard markers (2 per term)
- 1 x A4 Whiteboard
- 1 x Whiteboard duster / cloth
- 1 x Permanent marker (Artline 70 – black)
- 4 x A4 Plastic envelopes (white, red, yellow, blue- one) envelope for each term
- 15 x A4 Plastic Book Covers (A4 slip-on covers, Croxley brand, extra thick 140 micron (3 x 5 pack) **No decorative covers please. Must be clear and see through.**
- 4 x Boxes of tissues (1 per term)

Please note:

1. Refrain from buying colourful versions of Pritt and erasers. These tend to leave marks in the books.
2. Buy a sturdy ruler that indicates mm and cm. Do not buy bendable rulers as it is difficult to measure accurately with them.
3. Do not buy pencil bags or cases that are very big, as they take up too much space on the desks.
4. This stationery does not always last the entire year and will need to be topped up at the end of each term.
5. Please ensure that all of the learners' stationery is clearly labelled.
6. Please bring all the books and covers on the first day of school. We will cover the books in class. Please DO NOT decorate or cover any books at home.
7. All necessary stationery must be sent to school on the first day of school. All additional stationery must be stored at home until needed.
8. It is mandatory to pay the LTSM fee to the bursar by 30 January 2026. The fee of R100 is payable from 14 January 2026.
